EMERGENCY ACCESS PROGRAM

The Florence Police Department, Volunteers In Police Services in cooperation with the Western Pinal Association of REALTORS®, and the Arizona Regional Multiple Listing Service are providing a program to assist you when you need help the most.

In the event that you call for police, fire or medical assistance and you are unable to open your door, the emergency services will have access to you without damage to your property or delay in helping you.



























Florence Emergency Access Program

The Western Pinal Association of Realtors® who are funding this program, with matching financial support from The Arizona Regional Multiple Listing Service are the pilots of the this service.

The Florence Police Department, Volunteers In Police Services are providing delivery and installation of the "Key Safes" and maintaining records of installations and users of the service.

The Florence Police Department will be maintaining "non-public access" records on the program users and access information. This information will be used for the sole purpose of allowing the Florence Fire Department, Emergency Medical Services and Southwest Ambulance Services access into a structure during fire or medical emergencies when health, life preservation or property damage is immanent.

Only the Police Department will have the access codes in the emergency access information system.

Primary Program Purpose

The primary purpose of the Emergency Access Program is to provide access to a residence in times of Emergency Needs such as Fire or Medical emergencies; safe and quick entry for those who are in need; reduce or eliminate property damage during such emergencies.

The Florence Program is aimed initially towards the elderly, medically infirm, physically or mentally impaired in preparation for emergencies pertaining to their personal health and property safety.

In the event that an individual has a fire or medical emergency, and that individual can not open the door to allow Fire and Medical personnel in to assist them, or if a fire related emergency should occur, emergency personnel can quickly enter the structure without damaging the doors or windows.



Florence Police, Fire and Medical Services respond and assist those in need. Participating in the **Emergency Access Program** will make their job faster and safer for you!

Application Process

It is necessary for all individuals or businesses to complete an application process for the *Emergency Access Program*.

A donation of \$20.00 is recommended. However, if you are unable to afford the recommended donation, then any amount you can afford would be appreciated. The donation goes back to the Western Pinal Association of Realtors to defray the cost of maintaining the program. The donation is a one time fee for each building or structure and is non-refundable.
