

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF FLORENCE COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING OF THE FLORENCE TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON TUESDAY, JULY 3, 2018, AT 4:00 P.M., IN THE FLORENCE TOWN COUNCIL CHAMBERS, LOCATED AT 775 N. MAIN STREET, FLORENCE, ARIZONA.

CALL TO ORDER


ADJOURNMENT
