We are starting out the first month of the New Year with exciting news from our Fire Department. They have become a Premier Level EMA Agency, which is a prestigious recognition and received their certificate. The Town has met the new 2018 standards, which many agencies have not yet met. Currently, there are 60 agencies that have their certification based on the 2009 standards. However, the total is much smaller for those who have received the certification based on the 2018 standards. There is a very elite group who has earned this special designation. There are several criteria factors that are considered in becoming a Premier EMA Agency.

This past year, a highly successful Community Emergency Response Team (or "C.E.R.T. Team") was implemented. The C.E.R.T. Team accompanies our emergency response professionals to calls and trainings in which their resources, skills, and training create a safer environment for all. We will be providing our 2nd CERT course in January. Dates will be as follows:

Week 2 - Mon Jan 13, Wed Jan 15

Week 3 - Mon Jan 20, Wed Jan 22

Week 4 – Mon Jan 27, Wed Jan 29
