RE: Neighborhood Meeting for Proposed SunPower Solar Project

Dear Property Owner:

SunPower Corporation, Systems (SunPower) is planning annexation of property into the Town of Florence to develop an approximately 282 acre site for a solar project. In addition, the project will require a Minor General Plan Amendment to the Town's 2020 General Plan Land Use Map to change the land use designation on approximately 9 acres located along the subject site's Diversion Dam Road frontage from Open Space (OS) to Employment/Light Industrial (E/LI) and a Zone Change from initial comparable zoning, Single-Residential Ranchette (R1-R), to Planned Unit Development (PUD) zoning to develop a Photovoltaic solar facility on approximately 282 acres of land.

The site is roughly bounded by Bonnybrooke Road on the north, Padilla Road on the west, North Quail Run on the east, and East Diversion Dam Road on the south. Development of the site would include the construction of a solar photovoltaic facility of approximately 50 megawatts that includes interconnection facilities and an operations and maintenance building. The project will include an onsite project substation which will interconnect to a new SRP-owned interconnection facility also onsite. The proposed project is located on private land that is currently used for agriculture.

SunPower is hosting a neighborhood meeting to provide more information about the project and to give members of the public an opportunity to ask questions and provide comments about the project. The notification list of affected property owners is derived from current records of the Pinal County Assessor's Office. As those records are not always current, please feel free to notify your neighbors of this meeting date so all may have the opportunity to participate. Meeting information is as follows:


