



## Notice of Intention to Levy Primary Property Tax

The Town of Florence will hold a public hearing on July 6, 2020 on Ordinance No. 695-20 an ordinance levying a primary property tax.

The Town of Florence will adopt its final property tax levy for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 at a regular Town Council meeting on July 20, 2020. The levy amount will not be increased over the prior year.
